



KeHE Scholarships 2020/2021

The KeHE Cares Foundation Scholarship Program seeks to invest in students for their higher education, enabling them to pursue professional careers in their local communities. Award criteria will be based upon 3 areas: financial need, character and academic achievement.

Scholarship Award: \$1,000 each up to a total of 75 awards. The scholarship covers room/board, tuition/fees, paid directly to accredited institutions.

Eligibility: The scholarship is available to students of full-time and part-time employees. Students should be enrolled in an accredited undergraduate college, university, community college or trade school and, as a general rule, be claimed on your tax return. Students of employees that have titles of Director or above are not eligible to apply. Previous award winners and applicants may reapply. This program is also available to business partners of KeHE.

Selection Criteria (short essay question):

- Financial need
- Character
- Academics

Applications are due by June 5, 2020 at 11:59pm CST

Awards: Award recipients will be notified by email by June 15, 2020 and will be presented with a certificate indicating their award. The certificate contains all the information necessary for the student to claim their award and have the funding sent directly to their school. Funds must be used within one year of scholarship award date or recipient will forfeit the funds.

Scholarship Communications: The KeHE Cares Foundation Scholarship Program is promoted via company website, flyers and other communication channels.
